When the Mattsons family started their first sawmill in 1851 it is unlikely that the initial vision for the business included designing, building and delivering some of the finest beds available to happy and appreciative clients around the globe. A family business, at the time with only local business opportunities in focus, nearly two centuries later, Mattsons Beds are now available in finer boutiques and hotels far beyond the small village of Malmbäck, Småland in the south eastern part of Sweden. Nor is it very likely that the first

generation of artisans would have been able to foresee the great appreciation that meets the company around the world today. An appreciation confirming our vision that great quality, tradition and the values that a family owned company in its 5th generation represent, is not something you come across every day. Just like it was back in 1851, our number one priority is to make certain that our service and products remain at the level where it has been for the past two centuries, the very best possible.

HISTORY

1851 - The family business was started with Isak Mattson setting up a sawmill on the family estate Österkvarn, in Småland.

1879 - Karl Mattson takes over the family business and sees an opportunity for expansion. He opens a second sawmill in nearby Ramkvilla while he himself resides at Höreda Mellängård.

1899 - Karl's son, Frans Mattson representing the third generation of the family business gets involved and with time take charge of the business. Frans had a grand vision for the future and started to invest by purchasing vast amounts of forest around Småland.

1924 - As a part of furniture making, beds and mattresses had come to represent a substantial share of the whole and in 1924 Frans started Mattsons Beds. From this point the manufacturing of high quality beds and mattresses existed under its own flag. Quickly gaining a reputation of

being a producer of the best beds and mattresses in Sweden.

1947 - Torsten and Birgitta Mattson, representing the 4th generation of the family business, continues the search for ways to refine beds and mattress production, constantly looking for better filling materials and methods for improving the already high quality of their beds and mattresses.

1984 - The decision is made to relocate to the small Swedish west coast town of Falkenberg where they build a new factory. Tomas and Anders Mattson, representing the 5th generation, have been getting increasingly involved in the business and together they take over the management of the family business. Having been running around the factory since early childhood, the brother are well familiar with the ins and outs of the family business. The methods of producing beds are constantly refined, without ever compromising the quality that has become the trademark of Mattsons Beds.





CRAFTSMANSHIP

When building beds, as with life in general, there can be no shortcuts. In order for our craftsmen to build the best beds possible they need to work with the very best materials. From our century and a half of working with and supplying high quality wood, with nearly one hundred years of that time with the bedroom in focus, we have time and time again come to see that the original philosophy of Mattsons still holds true today and represents something that will never be outdated. Every Mattsons bed is handmade right here in Sweden. No exception, no shortcuts. Just a steady

focus on delivering genuine, long lasting quality and comfort, every time.

As was often the case in many part of Sweden at the time when company was started, local materials were the preference. Once Mattsons got into furniture manufacturing the wood that was used for the manufacturing therefore came from the company's own forests. For that purpose large areas of land was from time to time bought up for the purpose of having continuous access to high quality wood, something that still today is a very important part of Mattsons.

WOOL

Wool is a fascinating material that acts as a warm layer in cold weather and cools your body down when you are feeling warm. In other words, wool is a performance material of nature and is also inflammable. Wool is nature's miracle that is a performance material making an ideal partner for horsetail hair and cotton.

An optimal bed climate is enabled by the use of pure wool, which functions as a makeshift climate regulator of your bed. For a very long time, wool has been a renowned material for its capability to remain warm in cold and vice versa. Using wool, one can sleep comfortably at an optimal temperature and remain dry. The wool fiber has been structured in a way that enables large volumes of air to position themselves in between the fibers, therefore offering impeccable insulation properties while making it flexible, elastic, and resilient. Moreover, about 30 percent of the wool's weight in water can be absorbed by the material, without becoming wet.



COTTON

The ideal material to complement horsehair is cotton, which enables the entire body to breathe without any hassles. The material is popular for being soft and strong. It is safe to assume that this material is one of the softest ones offered by nature and is popular for providing comfort and breathability. With Mattsons soft cotton, the air is facilitated to circulate around the wearer's body, thereby ensuring that they remain dry and comfortable and enjoy a good sleep without any hassles. Consequently, you can enjoy longer, unperturbed sleep.

Every individual uses their lungs as well as their skin to breathe, as our skins have over 7 million pores that breathe and eliminate toxins. In order to remain dry and comfortable, sleeping on a bed that breathes properly and circulates air around your body is integral.



HORSEHAIR

When it comes to creating a good bed, very few materials are comparable to horsehair. Each curled strand of horsehair can operate as a small spring, thereby improving the functioning of our internal spring systems. Therefore, this offers support and pliability. Moreover, when one uses horsehair, they are also opting for the in-built, effective ventilation system.

Horsehairs function like miniature airways: each strand is a hollow tube that comes with a microscopic capillary action, eliminating moisture and accepting fresh air. Interestingly, its drying property is so prominent that soaking a strand in water and shaking it removes water almost instantaneously. In Mattsons bed, there are countless natural micro springs that channel away moisture and excess heat from your body, so you can enjoy a comfortable sleep. The absence of heat and moisture will ensure that you fall asleep sooner and immerse yourself in an unperturbed sleep so you wake up completely rejuvenated. Needless to say, your quality of sleep will be enhanced with these beds.



COCONUT COIR FIBER

The coconut fiber, also known as coir, comes from the inner husk of coconuts and for that reason dust mite resistant. Also as they are very suitable for people suffering from allergies. The thickness of coconut coir is very important. If the thickness of the fiber is very less it doesn't provide the required firmness for stability in our beds. At Mattsons Beds we use the coconut material for a straight and firm edge of the mattress.



PINE

At Mattson, the incorporation of slow-grown Swedish pine makes it solid. The bed becomes stable and strong, therefore providing unparalleled quality that is synonymous with reassurance. The wooden frames of Mattsons make each bed stable and strong, as they are made of Pine trees from Sweden's northern forests, which are chosen carefully. These trees grow at a slow pace, which improves their robustness. We value quality as well as environmental responsibility.

We take into consideration the way each pine grows and every forest regenerates due to our passion for nature. In a Mattson bed as well as headboards, every wooden frame is FSC-certified. In simple words, they can be traced back to their origin and they are created using pine that is harvested using methods to maintain the biodiversity of the forest, along with its productivity and ecological processes. All our bed frames come with a 25-year warranty.



SPRINGS

The Mattsons springs provide support and relieve pressure, without making a sound while aligning your body in an optimal position. The springs are scientifically robust mechanisms that form an integral part of the bed. We provide springs of top-notch quality which are manufactured in Sweden. Each Mattsons bed comes with at least two spring systems working in tandem. The springs that are soft and flexible, making the bed soft, coupled with springs that are firm, which are situated below to provide robust support. As these spring systems work together, the bed aligns with your body's shape to provide maximum support and relaxation. The springs used in our beds come with a 25-year warranty.

MATTSONS BEDS - COLLECTION

The Mattsons collection is built around five eight different beds; combinations of base, mattress and top mattress with a number of headboards and elegant leg options to complete the look of your bed. All of the designs of the collection are available to be built to order, just for you. Each season we will introduce new colors and headboard options that will form the look and color palette of the collection.

The who styles of bed designs we are working with for the Mattsons beds collection are the northern European –

and particular Scandinavian – frame style bed. A contemporary and practical design where the base and mattress are built as one with your choice of top mattress to fine tune the level of surface softness that is your preference. The second, and globally most common is the continental bed; bed base or divan, a middle mattress and top mattress. The top mattress is something that is more common in Scandinavia than in continental Europe and maybe so due to the high comfort demand that Scandinavians have on their beds.

BLK VLVT





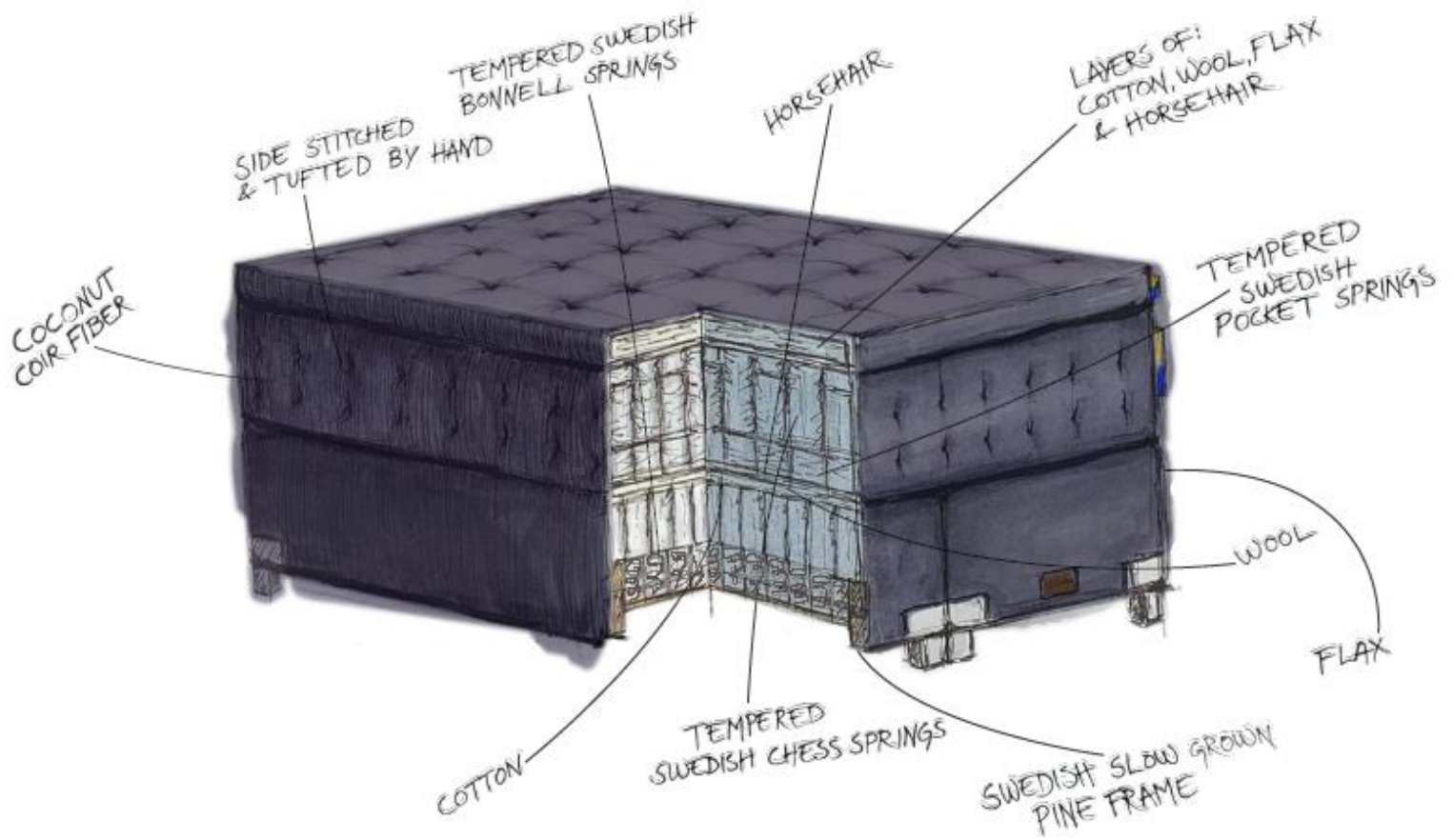
Design for ultimate comfort, as the flag ship model of the Mattsons collection the BLK VLVT is an expression of absolute elegance, an experience of luxury without compromise to design, materials and production time. As with all Mattsons beds, the BLK VLVT experience starts with a base of solid, slow growing pine wood and two separated spring systems. The main mattress features one Swedish steel pocket spring system and one Swedish chess pocket system surrounded by layers and layers of cotton, wool, horsehair and corners reinforced by coconut coir fiber.

- 58cm excl. top mattress and legs.

Materials:

- 12cm Swedish slow grown pine frame.
- Layers of cotton & horse hair.
- 6cm tempered Swedish bonnell springs.
- 13cm tempered Swedish pocket springs.
- Layers of cotton, wool, flax & horsehair.
- Corners made of flax and coconut coir fiber.
- 6cm tempered Swedish pocket springs.
- 15cm tempered Swedish chess springs.
- Layers and layers of cotton, wool and horsehair.
- Side stitched and tufted by hand.



ELEGANCE





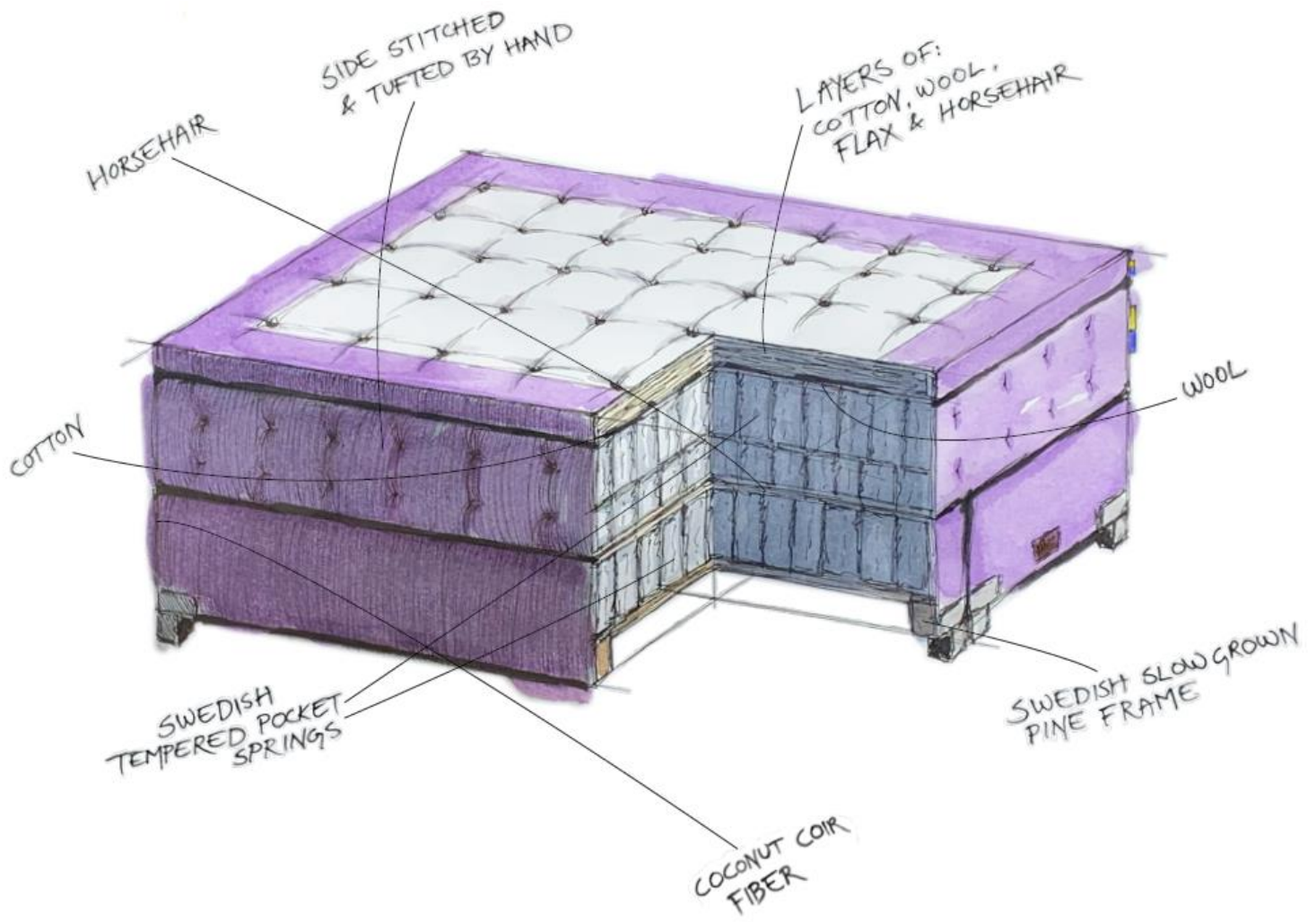
Elegance is built on a base of Swedish slow growing pine, with tempered steel pocket springs, together with layers of cotton and horsehair, the Elegance bed has a responsive, steady support system for a soft deep sleep. The main mattress features two separate heights of pocket spring system combined with layers of cotton, wool and horse hair, creating a feeling of deep and flexible support and comfort. To stabilize the Elegance, the craftsmen of Mattsons hand stitch and tuft the mattress for a more luxury design.

- 57cm excl. top mattress and legs.

- 12cm Swedish slow grown pine frame.
- Layers of cotton & horsehair.
- 13cm tempered Swedish pocket springs.
- Layers and layers of cotton, wool, flax and horsehair.
- Corners made of flax and coconut coir fiber.
- 9cm tempered Swedish pocket springs.
- 13cm tempered Swedish pocket springs.
- Layers and layers of cotton, wool and horsehair.
- Side stitched and tufted by hand.



PURE





A bed some regards as the most exclusive beds of the Mattsons collection. As with all of our beds, the base is made out of Swedish slow growing pine wood. On top of the base, a mattress with two sets of tempered steel pocket springs that combined with layers of cotton, wool and horsehair. Delivers comfort in the way only a Mattsons can. The Pure has a responsive, steady support and creates a feeling like no other.

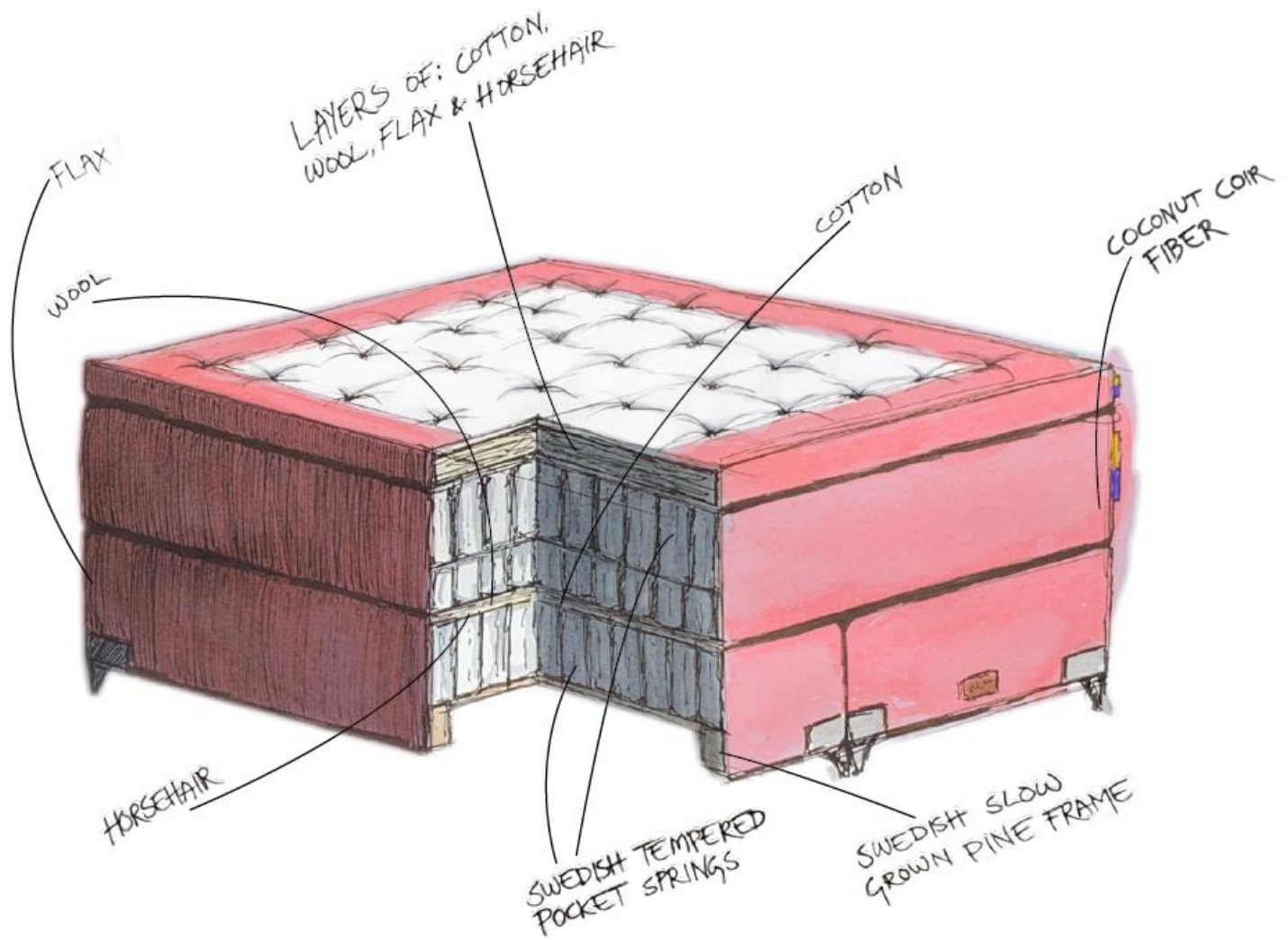

The Soulful bed has two pocket spring systems in the main mattress. Still, the bed features a slightly lower profile for a more contemporary look, naturally without in any way compromising with the great feeling of support and comfort that a Mattsons delivers. Like the name suggests, this is a great feeling bed, soft and comforting while perfectly supporting from its structure and the layering of the filling materials. A Mattsons in every way.

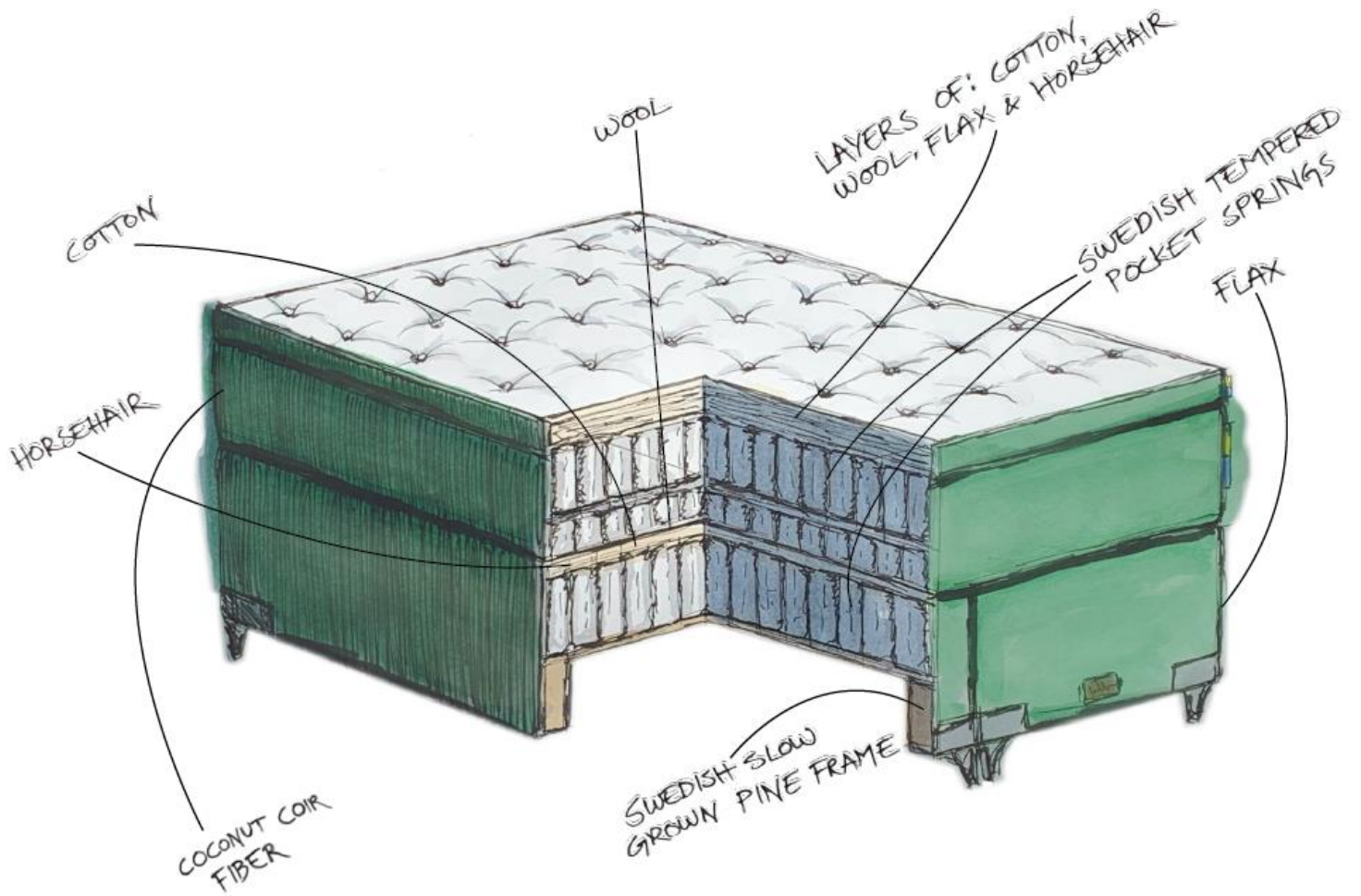

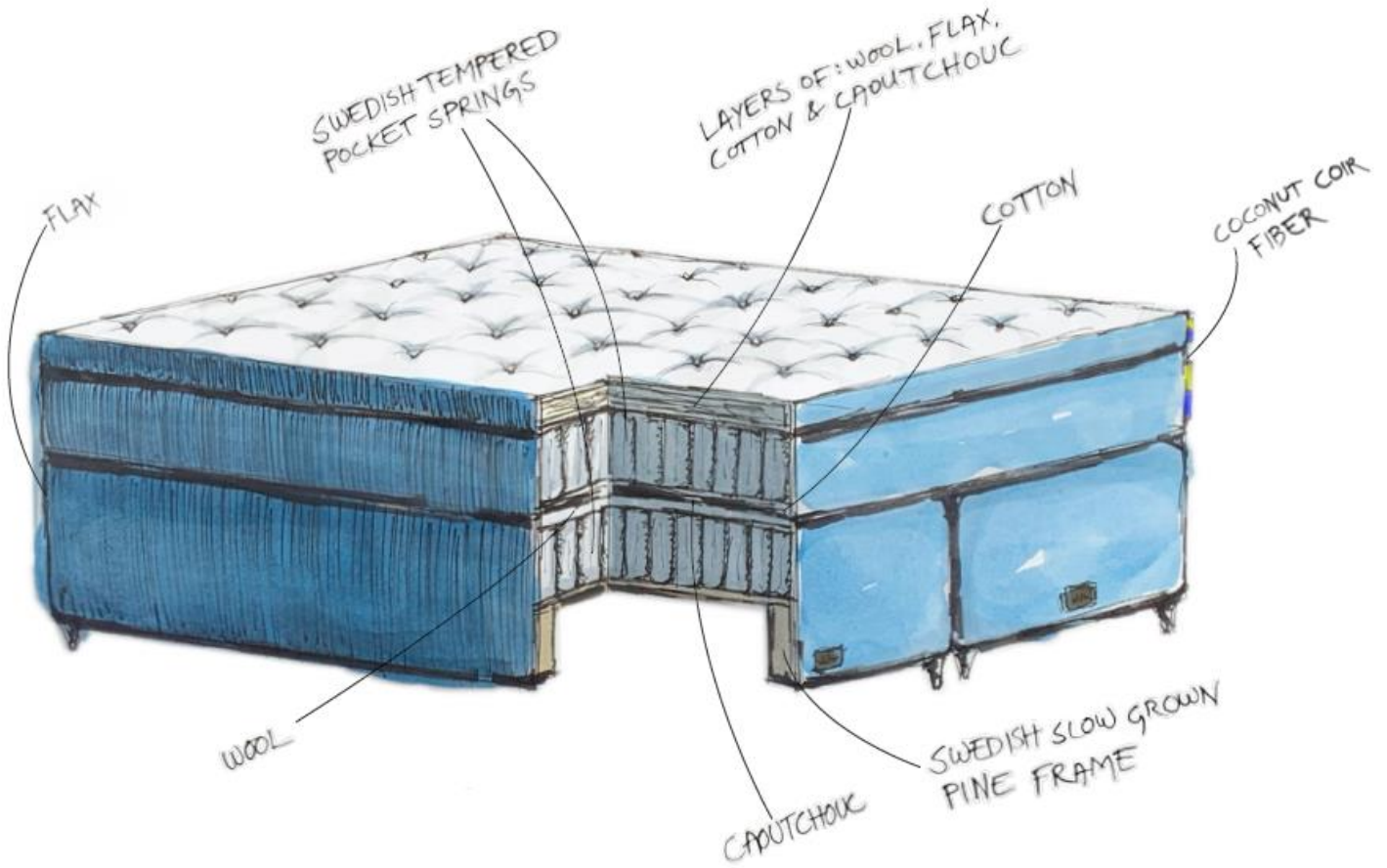

STRAND





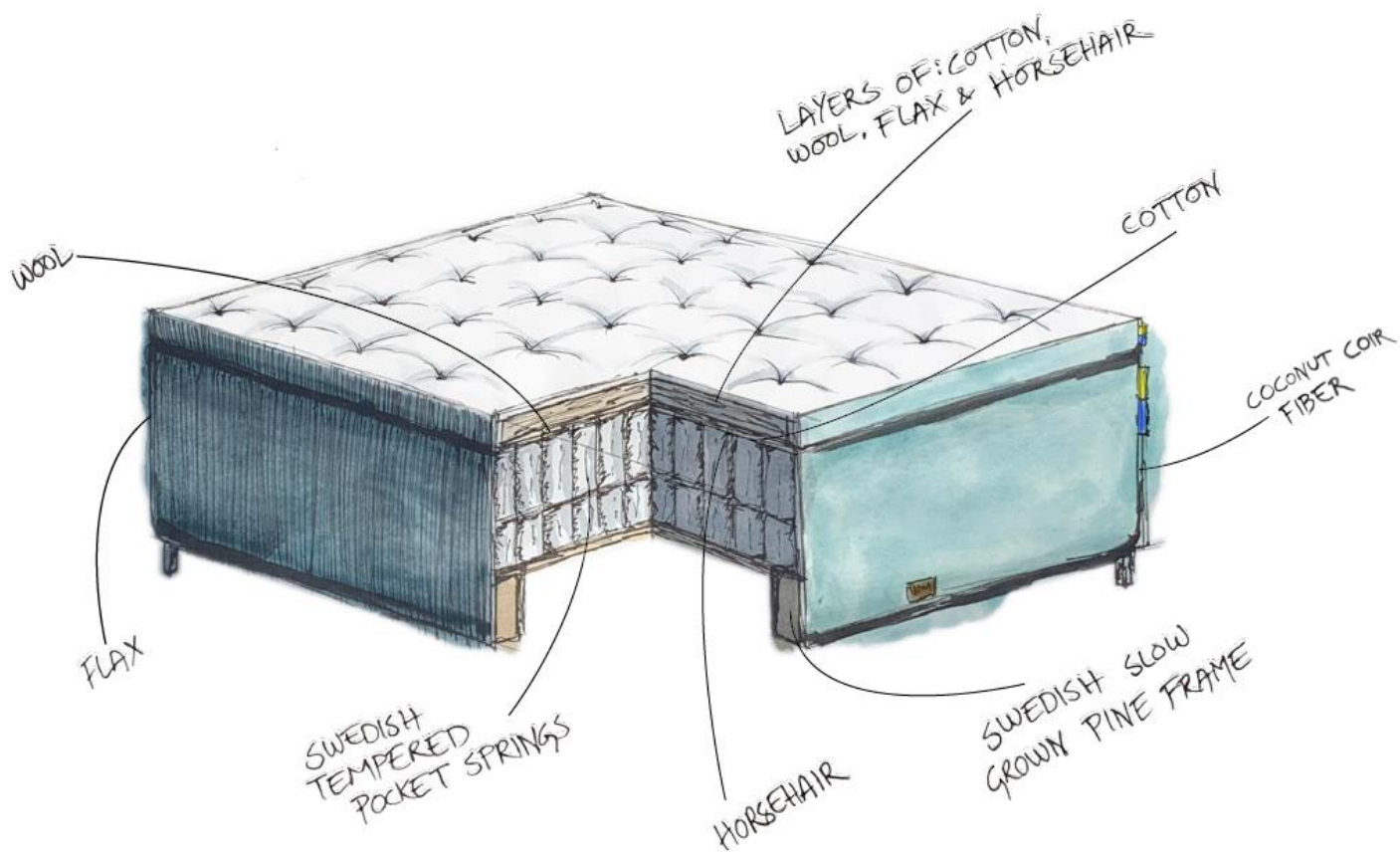

The floating sensation of comfort that is the Strand is created in part due to the stacking of the spring systems at the bottom of the base. Just as with our Continental style beds, layers of cotton, wool, flax and horse hair are used to make sure the feeling of comfort is exceptional.

- 16cm Swedish slow grown pine frame.
- 9cm Swedish tempered pocket spring.
- 13cm Swedish tempered pocket spring.
- Corners made of flax and coconut coir fiber.

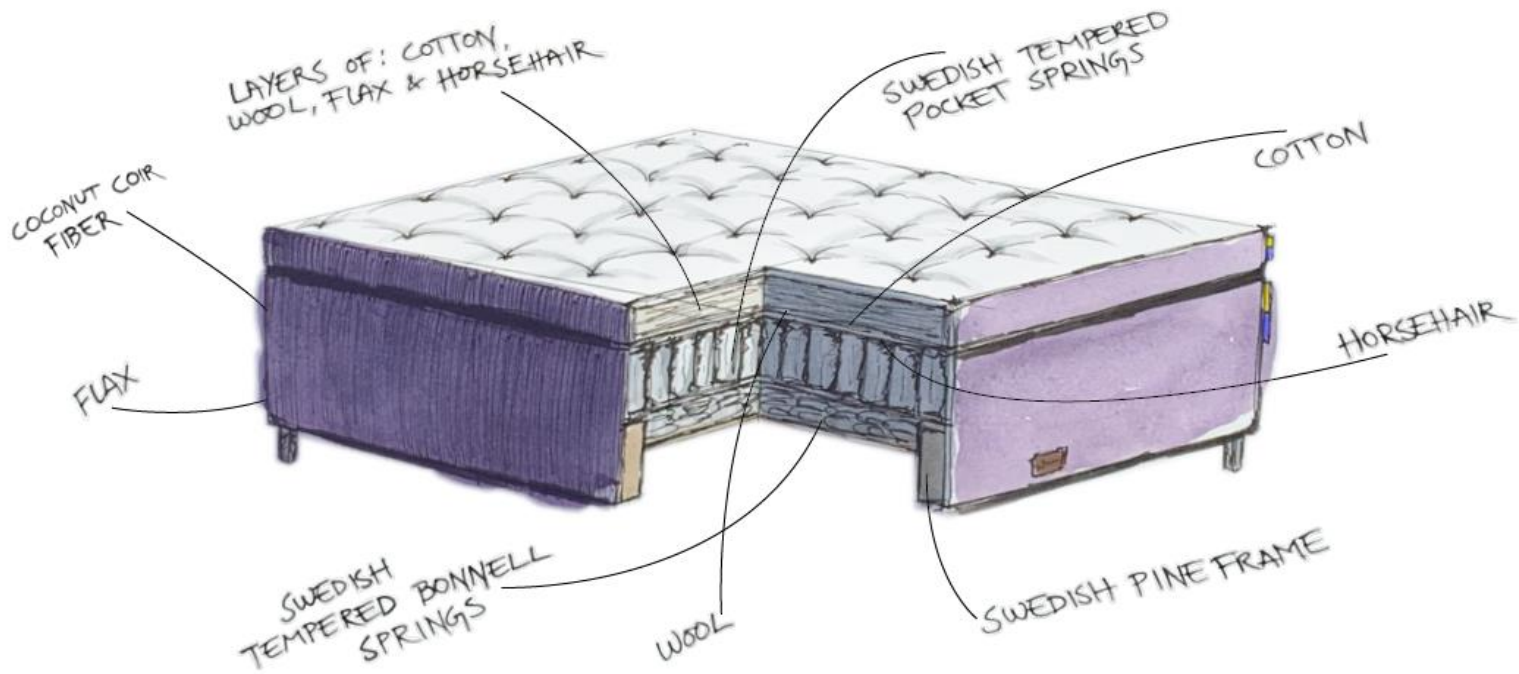

Layers of pure Cotton and Wool surrounds the horsehair pad. A high quality cotton, linen mix fabric encloses the comfort created, with contrast color cotton tufts keeping the filling materials in place. Hand crafted in Sweden, like no other.

- 10-12cm

Materials:

- Layers of cotton, wool and horsehair.
- Tufted by hand.



TAGEL KUVERT – Top Mattress

The Tagel Kuvert top mattress is made in the same way as the Tradition with the one difference being the cotton stretch fabric used to make the top mattress even more pliant. For a more luxurious look.

Height:

- 10-12cm.

Materials:

- Layers of cotton, wool and horsehair.
- Tufted by hand.



TAGEL STRETCH – Top Mattress

The Tagel Stretch top mattress is made in the same way as the Tradition with the one difference being the cotton stretch fabric used to make the top mattress even more pliant. For you who wants a little extra surface softness from your bed.

Height:

- 10-12cm.

Materials:

- Layers of cotton, wool and horsehair.
- Tufted by hand.



CAOUTCHOUC STRETCH – Top Mattress

The Caoutchouc Stretch top mattress is made in the same way as the Tagel with the one difference being the core material used are soft natural caoutchouc. For you who wants a little extra softness from your bed.

Height:

- 10-12cm.

Materials:

- Layers of cotton, wool and caoutchouc.
- Tufted by hand.





CARE FOR YOUR BED AND MATTRESS - When you take care of your bed and mattress in a proper manner it will give you comfort and enjoyment for many years to come. Since the Mattsons Beds are made from all natural materials the right care is important. By following these simple instructions your bed will keep looking and feeling beautiful and give you the best sleep possible.

THE MAIN MATTRESS - Month one to four, please turn your mattress every two weeks. The first time you should turn the mattress length wise; head to toe. The second time; right to left, then again head to toe followed by a right to left turn. By turning the mattress in this manner, for two full rotations, you will ensure that the filling materials of the mattress settle in the best possible

manner, this will result in better comfort and a longer life for the mattress.

Month five to eighteen, please continue to turn your mattress according to the above described pattern every three months, allowing for one additional full rotation of the mattress.

After the initial eighteen months it will be sufficient to turn the mattress every six months.

TOP MATTRESS - Turn the top mattress according to the same method used for the main mattress. Every two weeks for the initial six months and thereafter once every month. As with the main mattress, proper care of your top mattress will allow for years of great comfort and support, two main ingredients to great sleep.

The Mattsons Beds headboard collection is built around four basic designs; Straight, Dunes, Studs and Buttons. All of the headboards are available in a number of different fabrics and colors along with several finishing details such as studs, buttons, piping and stitching to allow you to personalize your headboard and give you a good reason to leave your bedroom door open.

Legs

The Mattsons bed legs come in many shapes and heights. This way, you can match your bedding with the legs of your choice; the result will be personalized and adapted to your wishes. Mattsons Beds have developed a range of bed legs designs to meet your expectation.
